As a Beverage Server, you will:

- Provide friendly and efficient service in cocktail lounges, tropical deck bars, cafes, fast-paced nightclubs and *Castaway Cay* beaches
- Practice up selling and suggestive selling techniques
- Assist in maintaining cleanliness of areas to meet United States Public Health (USPH) standards
- Work with a diverse team of 975 Crew Members (60 on the Beverage Team) of over 50 nationalities
- Learn the finer details about dozens of cocktails, wines, beers and spirits



Sell and serve beverages to Guests in bars, lounges, café and beaches



The Schedule

- § Work an average of 84 hours per week during a 6-month contract
- § May request up to 10 hours additional overtime per week
- § Have time off during your day, but no days off

You will be subject to random alcohol/drug testing.

- 8:30am-9:00am** < Breakfast in the Crew Mess
- 9:30am-12:00pm** < Clock-in, *Castaway Cay* Beach Bar
- 12:00pm-1:00pm** < Lunch Break
- 1:00pm-6:00pm** < Pinocchio's and Signals on Deck 9
- 6:00pm-9:00pm** < Break (Nap Time!)
- 9:00pm-11:00pm** < Pinocchio's Bar



Pay Day

You will be in a tipped position. Disney Cruise Line adds 15% gratuity to every Guest beverage check. Additional gratuity may be added for exceptional service. The higher your sales, the more you will earn! Ask your recruiter for more details. While on contract, DCL will provide medical care, disability and death benefits. In a tipped position, you are responsible for your joining flight. DCL will provide subsequent flights.

Home Sweet Home

You will share a small yet functional cabin with 1 or 2 additional Crew Members (of the same gender) possibly from another culture. Cabins are complete with a TV/DVD player, wireless Internet at a reduced rate, a personal lockable storage space and beverage cooler. Phone service is available in cabin, in port and via a pre-paid cellular service. DCL provides room, board and meals.

Training

- › **Shore side:** Two days of training in Lake Buena Vista, FL to finalize hire paperwork and learn Disney heritage and Disney Cruise Line's respectful culture of working and living
- › **Onboard:** Safety, Social Responsibility and Crowd Management training including crew drills to meet STCW'95 standards
- › **On-the-job:** Responsible sales of alcohol, product knowledge, technology such as Micros point of sales system, up selling, United States Public Health (USPH) standards and more
